Programme Implementation Approach:- CFAR interventions follow a five-pronged approach as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Policy advocacy on rights and entitlements on persons living in poverty, vulnerable situations and in occupations which make them more vulnerable to risks, stigma and discrimination (policy advocacy) ▪ Placing communities and at the centre of all intervention and honing their capabilities and leadership in planning, monitoring and review (community - rights based) ▪ Service inclusion through the community led single window mechanism across all development programmes (service-based) ▪ Strengthening voice, agency and building capacities of marginal groups to shape their inclusion (community based) ▪ Focus on gender inclusive and rights based approach across all endeavours (gender-inclusive) <p>2. Thematic Areas of Work</p> <p>➤ Social Inclusion- Welfare Schemes and Services</p> <p>Since 2005, CFAR has assisted government to identify and deliver social entitlements and welfare schemes and bring changes in the lives of people. In this endeavour, we developed innovative approaches and found our niche in empowering community-led platforms to connect a cross-section of marginalised communities – including the urban poor, the girl child, adolescents, single women, persons with disabilities, unorganized workers and key populations most vulnerable such as transgender persons and sexual minorities, sex workers and people living with HIV– with government and specific departments. These community-led platforms called “Single Window”. They are established in both government premises and in community facilities. Today they are evolving slowly but surely into digital Single Window or e-Mitra or common service centres. They are linked with the community through a team of Help-desk members in each ward and settlement where the community is striving to secure social entitlements. CFAR has built the capacity of the community with the support of experts</p>

from think tank bodies, government and its agencies and civil society organizations. These approaches have been tested and strengthened across cities and states. More recently, CFAR is facilitating the set up a community-led Workers Facilitation Centers across four districts for improving access to social protection schemes and services for informal sector workers

➤ **Water, Sanitation and Hygiene**

As part of the Central government flagship programme, Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), AMRUT and Jal Jeewan Misson, CFAR enhanced community participation at many levels to not only end open defecation but also to leverage the programme to improve access to safe and gender inclusive sanitation. This has been implemented intensively in Jaipur and Bhubaneswar and replicated in other cities such as Bangalore, Pune, Ajmer and Kolkata. Presently with the increased focus on climate change and its direct impact on marginal groups living in resource poor habitats, the WASH programmes are integrating aspects of climate-resilience into WASH programming

➤ **Media Engagement on Reproductive, Maternal, New-born, Child, Adolescent Health and Nutrition and National Disease Control Programme**

We provide support to Government of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, National Health Mission, Technical Support Unit in UP and CARE in Bihar in strengthening health communication and media engagement on RMNCHA+N and National Disease Control Programme. We ensured that all small and big successes achieved in the area of RMNCHA +N were documented and change agents from the community and champions from the system were profiled and the information shared with the media.

➤ **Health Advocacy and Communication Support for LF and VL Elimination**

CFAR supports Department of Health in UP and Bihar in creating a strong communication framework for Lymphatic filariasis (LF)&Visceral Leishmaniasis (VL) elimination including building a patient-led and community centred movement on both these diseases in promoting patient perspective, articulating and demanding inclusive policymaking, and seeking engagement from government and other key stakeholders for eradication of vector borne-diseases

➤ **Livelihood and Social Enterprise**

Across cities CFAR supports formation of Self-help groups (SHGs) and federated Area Level Federation-Shahri Manch under the aegis of National Urban Livelihood Mission-Mission Shakti in Bhubaneswar, Jaipur, Kolkata and Delhi. These forums comprise of marginal women, persons with disabilities, trans persons, sanitary workers, who are trained in Panchsutra, financial literacy and skilled with support of government agencies. Post training linkages for loans through Lead banks and other micro-financing schemes are facilitated to enable them to set up home based social enterprise, small businesses, secure government contracting services or placements in private sector agencies. This multi-pronged approach leads to both empowerment as well as poverty alleviation through social mobility. CFAR supported SHGs are manufacturing environmental friendly sanitation products, doing city beautification, managing FSTP, STP, Water Kiosks, Community Toilet Complex, and Cesspool operations; some are involved in beauty therapy, computer operations and food industry.
